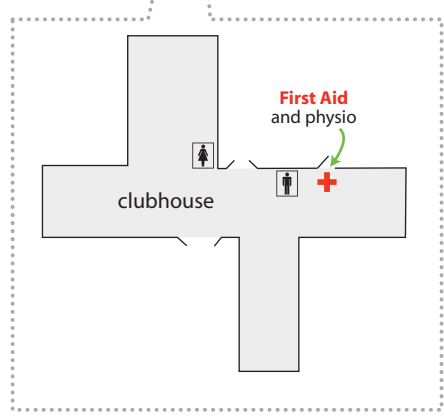
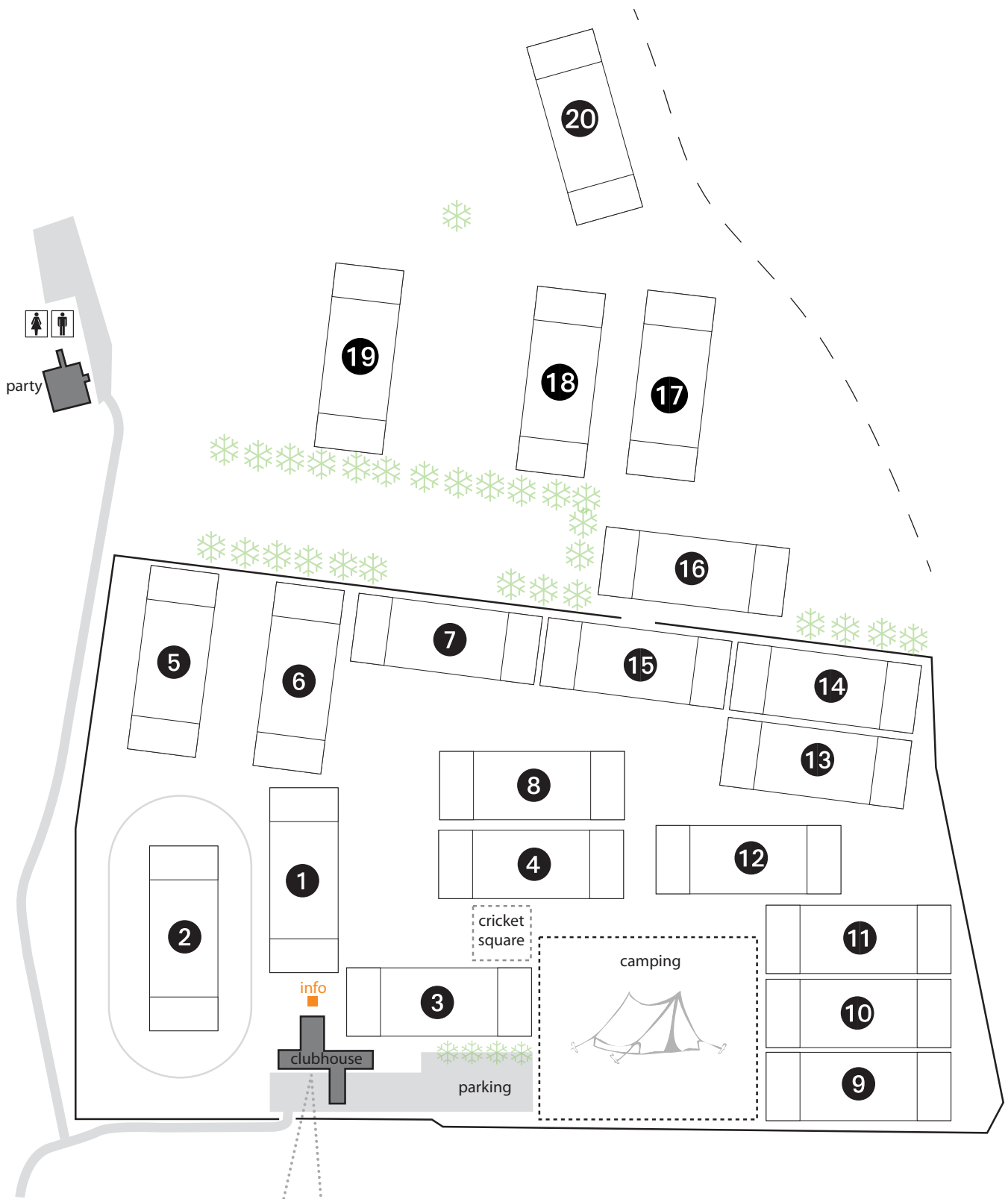
## **Naughty stuff**

## How to work out a three way tie:

A great way to impress girls and maybe improve your final position.

“Point differential between team’s won-loss records, counting only games between the teams that are tied.”

This is the first rule, which will hopefully solve your situation. If in any doubt, please come to the TD desk where we have a document explaining the remaining eight rules.

**Note** also that we do not use the point differential to choose the winner and then go “head to head” to choose the other two. *We must apply a tie-breaker rule equally to all the teams that are tied.* If this does not solve the three way tie (ie two teams have equal points difference) then you do end up separating them head-to-head (once the other team has been removed).

### EXAMPLE

Paper, Stone, Scissors are in a three-way tie for first place.

Paper beat Stone 15†-10\*,  
 Stone beat Scissors 15- 12,  
 Scissors beat Paper 15\*\*-13††.

*Let’s assume we are Paper.*

First, **add up the points you have scored** against the other two teams (15+13=28).

Secondly, **add up the points scored against you** (10+15=25).

Finally, **subtract the second number from the first** (28-25=3).

Therefore your points differential is ‘+ 3’.

**Now do this for the other two teams and then rank the teams by the points differential.**

Paper’s point differential, then, is +3.  
 Stone’s is -2 and Scissors’s is -1.

Paper finishes first, Scissors finishes second, and Stone finishes third.

**Check:** The three point differentials must always add up to zero (+3 -2 -1 = 0).
